WILDLIFE HAZARD REMOVAL & DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

JUNE 17, 2024 - SUMMER 2025




Project Background

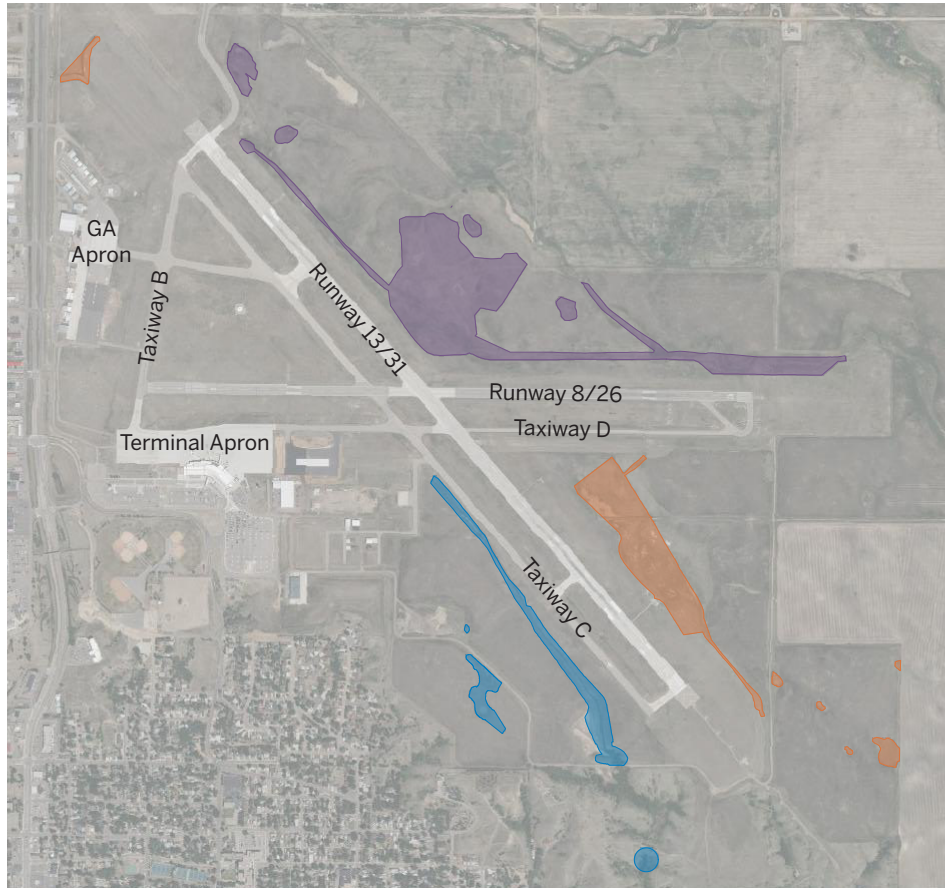
This project will enhance safety at the airport by removing nearly 20 acres of hazardous wildlife attractants near the runway. The project also includes grading that will improve drainage at the airport and reduce the risk of flooding. Additionally, underground storm pipe will be installed to reduce ponding near the runway.

This project is expected to begin June 17, 2024 with construction concluding in 2025.

Temporary closures of Runway 8/26 and Taxiway C are expected for short durations throughout the project. Impacts to Instrument Approach Procedures are also anticipated. Always check NOTAMs for the latest airfield conditions.
