MINOT INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

TAXIWAY B2 & T-HANGAR TAXILANE RECONSTRUCTION

(June 17 - August 3, 2024)

The construction is weather dependent and the dates listed are subject to change if inclement weather conditions occur.

Project Background

Minot International Airport will be reconstructing Taxiway B2 and the T-hangar taxilanes this summer. The project is divided into two phases. Reconstruction of Taxilanes A & B will be completed in Phase 1, including demo, aggregate base, and new asphalt paving. Reconstruction of Taxiway B2 will be completed in Phase 2, including demo, grading, aggregate base, asphalt paving, pavement marking, jointing, and electrical work. In addition to the work listed above, there is bituminous patching work that will be completed on Taxiway F with this project. The work on Taxiway F will restrict access from the south hangar area to the rest of the airfield for approximately 2 calendar days in July.

The airport will provide free aircraft parking on the GA Apron tiedowns for the impacted tenants for the duration of the closures. Contact Airport Administration for more details on aircraft parking. The project is expected to start on **June 17th and last through August 3rd**.

Schedule

Phase 1 (Taxilane Reconstruction): 24 working days

Phase 2 (Taxiway B2 Reconstruction): 18 working days
