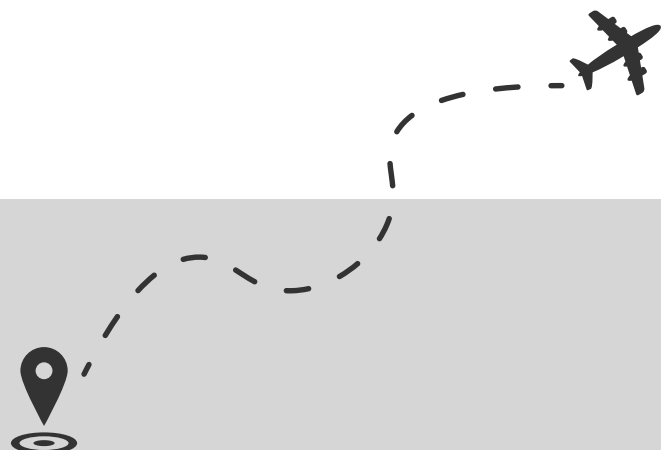

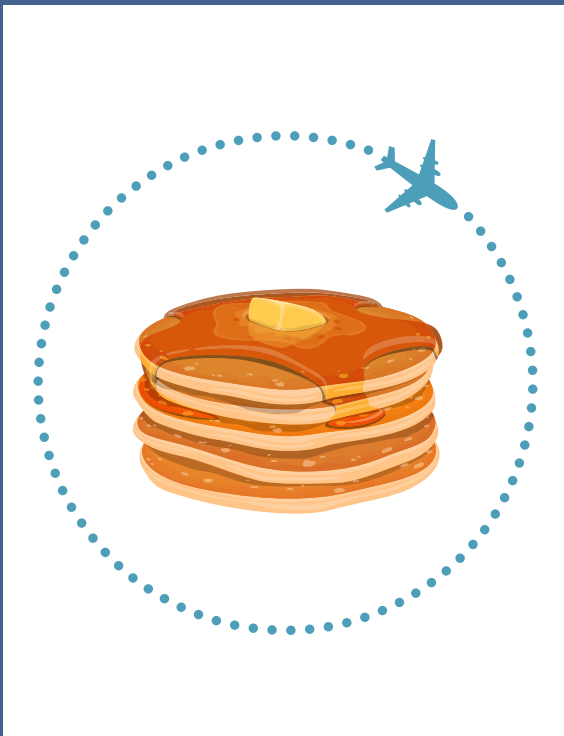


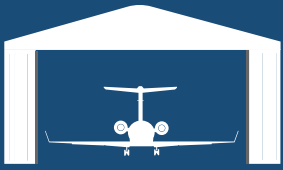
FLY-IN AND PANCAKE FEED

Terminal Tenant Spotlight



Overland West, Inc., started as a Hertz Rent-A-Car licensee in 1941. At the time, our company's name was W. Gwilliam, Inc., named for the founder, Wilford Gilwilliam. Mr. Gwilliam chose to start his car rental business in Ogden, Utah because his vision was to provide car rental services to railroad passengers, and Ogden was home to the largest train depot between Chicago and the west coast. After WWII, Mr. Gwilliam opened several other Hertz franchises in cities that had viable train depots, including Las Vegas, Nevada, which he sold back to the Hertz Corporation in the 1950's after air travel took center stage in the travel industry.

Our current owner, Mr. Jerry H. Petersen, went to work for W. Gwilliam, Inc. while going to college in 1962, and was eventually named General Manager. In 1976, Mr. Petersen entered into an agreement to purchase the company and legally changed the Company's name to Overland West, Inc. At the time Mr. Petersen purchased the company, the company was operating Hertz Rent-A -Car franchises in airports serving seven cities, four of which we currently operate.

Since acquiring the company, Mr. Petersen has made numerous acquisitions from the Hertz Corporation and other licensees, and today we operate 28 Hertz franchises in 7 states, 7 Dollar franchises 6 states, and 8 Thrifty franchises in 6 states. Our company continues to grow, and we expect to add more locations within the next year.

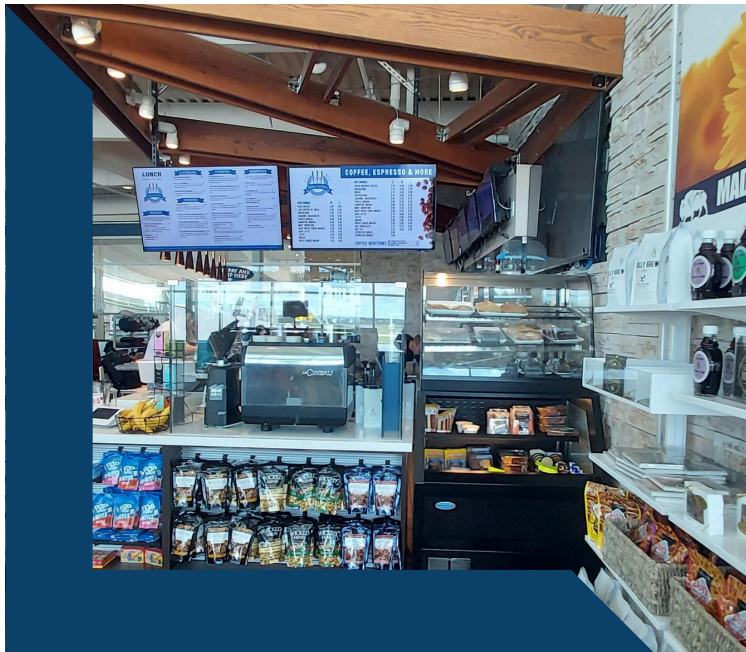
On July 1, 2017, we purchased the Hertz franchise in Minot, adding Minot to our list of locations in North Dakota. We currently operate Bismarck, Minot, Dickinson, Williston, Grand Forks, and Fargo! Making us the only Hertz Rent-A-Car provider in North Dakota.



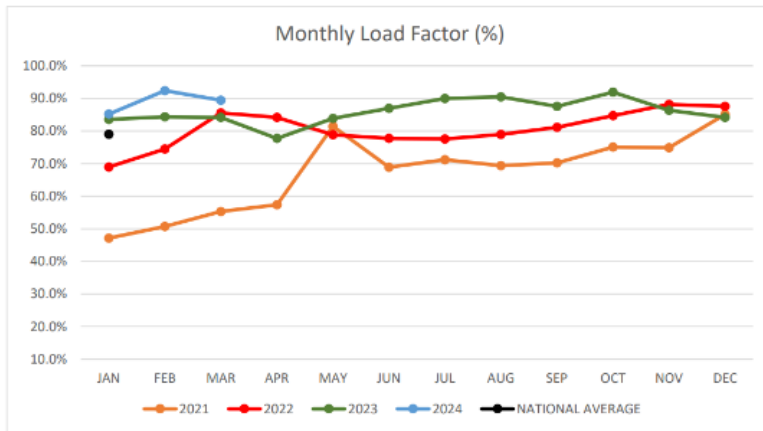

Trestle Tap House Renovation

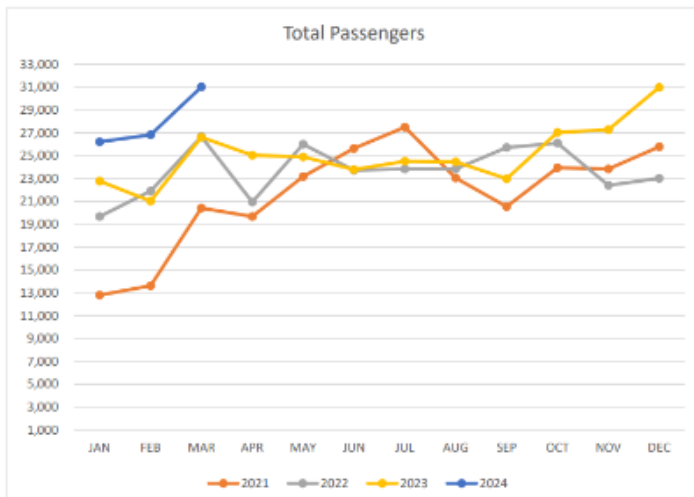
The renovations are complete and the new improved Trestle Tap House including some new displays for ND products and more grab and go options. Stop by and check it out!



The Business of Airports



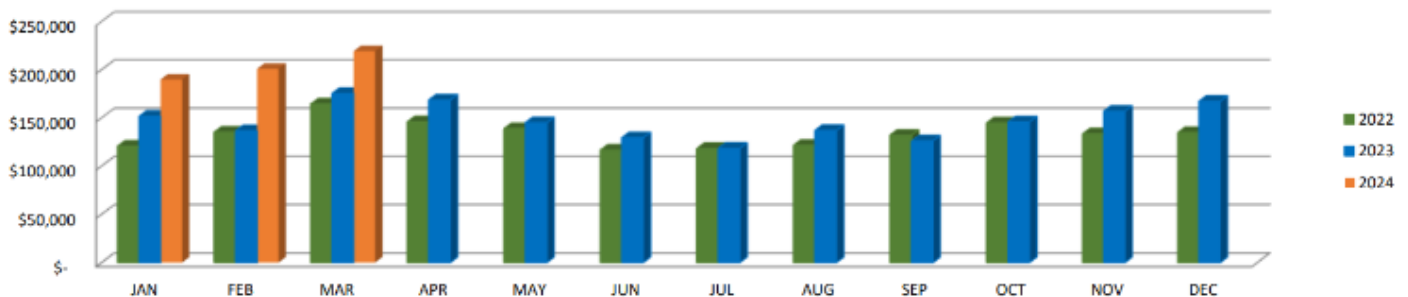
With the addition of the newest destination of Sanford Orlando the Airport has been busier during the first few months of the year than normal. These flights have had consistently high load factors performing well above our averages the first quarter averages in 2023 and the national average.



With the increase of flights, the concessionaires in and around the airport have had growth and a great start to 2024. Comparison to 2021-2023 numbers shows statistically lower averages in the Jan-March timeframe.



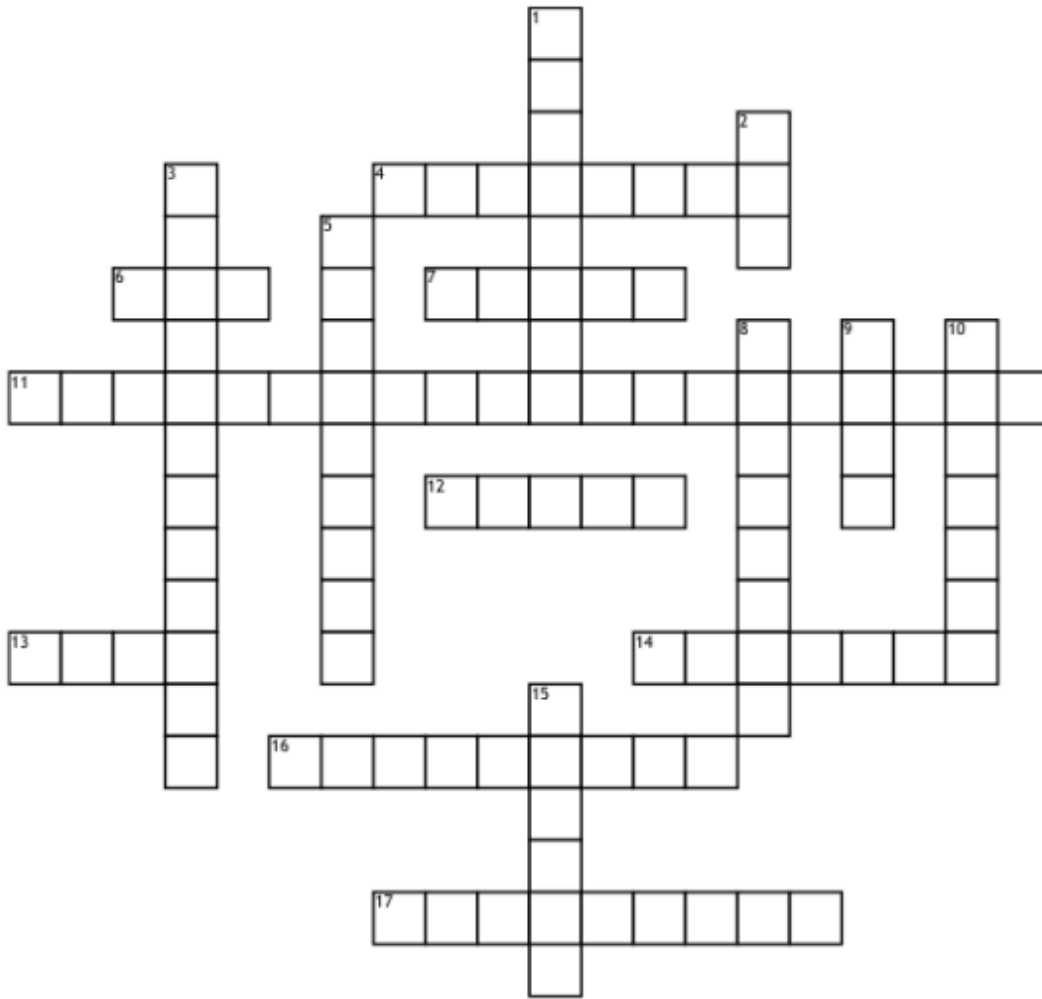
