This is the fourteenth weekly newsletter update regarding the summer 2024 construction projects at Minot International Airport.

TAXIWAY B2 AND TAXILANES A & B RECONSTRUCTION

- Phase 2 construction continued this week on Taxiway B2. The fourth week of construction involved asphalt paving, improvements to drainage infrastructure and electrical work.
- Taxiway B was reopened on Tuesday evening and Taxiway B2 will be reopened following pavement marking work that will occur next week.
- Taxiway F pavement patching has been completed and the Taxiway has been reopened.

WILDLIFE HAZARD REMOVAL PROJECT

- The contractor has continued ditch excavation in the Phase 1 area of the project, construction of embankment areas in the Phase 2 work area, and installation of storm water infrastructure in the Phase 1 & 2 work areas.
- To accommodate adjacent grading work, Taxiway C will be closed from Taxiway F to Taxiway C4 on a daily basis between 7:00AM and 8:30PM.
- Project Lookahead**
 - Next week, the contractor will continue with the excavation and embankment construction carried out this week and continue to install storm water infrastructure in the Phase 1 & 2 work areas.
 - Taxiway C is expected to reopen following the completion of Phase 1A construction, which is expected to be on Friday, September 20th.
