This is the seventeenth weekly newsletter update regarding the summer 2024 construction projects at Minot International Airport.

WILDLIFE HAZARD REMOVAL PROJECT

- The contractor has completed construction in critical areas at the northwest and southwest ends of the primary runway to allow for aircraft instrument procedures to recommence this week.
- Phase 3 construction in the northeast quadrant of the airport is commencing this week with storm sewer and drain tile installation.
- Phase 1A construction adjacent to Taxiway C is primarily complete. Remaining utility and landscaping work to occur at a time to be determined.
- Project Lookahead**
 - Next week, the contractor will continue with installation of Phase 3 utilities, continue to finalize grading/shaping for airfield drainage ditches in the Phase 1 and Phase 2 project areas, and proceed with Retention Basin A improvements at the south end of the airport.
