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Wildlife Hazard Removal

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This is the twenty fourth weekly newsletter update regarding the summer 2024 construction projects at Minot International Airport.

WILDLIFE HAZARD REMOVAL PROJECT

- Construction is substantially complete in the Phase 1 area (southwest quadrant of the airport) and Phase 2 area (southeast quadrant of the airport).
- The majority of Phase 3 earthwork construction in the northeast quadrant of the airport has been completed. Construction is being halted due to winter weather conditions.
- Retention basin A storm sewer pipe and impact structure have been installed. The remainder of backfill and restoration at the site is being halted due to winter weather conditions.
- **Project Lookahead**
 - After November 21, construction operations will generally be halted until the Spring of 2025.
 - Spring construction efforts at the Phase 3 project site will include completion of drain tile installation, topsoil placement, and landscaping/turf establishment. Backfill and restoration of the Retention Basin A site will also be completed in the spring.
