MINOT INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

GENERAL AVIATION ACCESS ROAD RECONSTRUCTION (PHASE 1)



Project Background

The Minot International Airport (MOT) will be reconstructing a portion of the existing General Aviation Access Road this summer. The work area will generally include the roadway south of the Airport Fire Station (Phase 1), and the roadway to the north will be rehabilitated in a future year (Phase 2).

The project will include the full removal and replacement of the existing pavement, aggregate base, curb & gutter, and street lighting. The contractor will be responsible to maintain traffic control and tenant access throughout the project, as shown on the graphic below.

Work is anticipated to begin on September 2, 2025, with a 28 calendar day overall duration.

*Vehicle gate G4 will not be accessible during construction. Tenants can utilize vehicle gate G2 (north of Avflight) to access the GA Apron.



Schedule

The project is anticipated to begin on September 2, 2025 and run through the end of September. The contractor is allowed 28 calendar days to achieve substantial completion.



Construction Impact

- The portion of roadway that is under construction will not be accessible. Alternate tenant parking and routing is shown in the above graphic.
- The contractor will maintain and protect (2) pedestrian access locations across the construction area for tenant/customer access throughout construction.
- Vehicle Gate G4 will not be accessible during construction. Gate G2 (north of Avflight) will remain available for GA apron access.
- Tenants should utilize caution when driving/walking near the active construction site.



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Note: The construction is weather dependent and the dates listed are subject to change if inclement weather conditions occur.
