MINOT INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

GA ACCESS ROAD TOPOGRAPHIC SURVEY AND SOIL BORINGS

(February 19, 2025)

Project Background

The Minot International Airport (MOT) is planning to reconstruct a portion of the existing GA Access Road serving the northwest portion of the airfield. This project will improve the condition and longevity of the roadway, ensuring continued safe access for airport tenants and users.

Preliminary design activities, including soil borings and a topographic survey, are scheduled to begin next week. Construction is anticipated to take place in late summer or fall of 2025.

As part of this process, topographic survey and soil boring work will be conducted on **Wednesday, February 19**. The GA Access Road will remain open, and crews will coordinate with automobile traffic to maintain access to tenants. Airport tenants should exercise caution while driving near the soil boring drill rig.
